

THE GREATER WINS

Objective: Compare and order whole numbers

Materials: Worksheet
One die per person

Procedures:

- Players work in pairs
- Player 1 rolls the die and fills in one of the seven spaces in the first problem. For example, if the player rolls a 3, the number can be placed in the ones, tens, hundreds, thousands, ten thousands, hundred-thousands, or millions place.
- Once the number has been written, it cannot be changed.
- The second player then rolls the die and writes the number in a space.
- Play continues until all blanks are filled.
- After the spaces are filled, the players alternate writing a $>$, $<$, or $=$ sign in the rectangle between the numbers.
- The player with the larger number wins.

Alternate game

- Players play again but instead of writing the number shown on the die on their board, they place the number on their opponent's board. Again, the player with the greater number wins.
