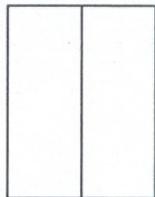


## How to Make "Strip Sliders"

1. Fold an 8 ½ x 11 sheet of white paper in half vertically.

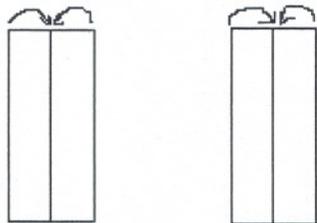


2. Cut paper in half along fold.

3. Fold each half vertically again to find the middle of your half.



4. Unfold and then fold the paper so that the vertical edges meet at the identified middle.



5. Take a small post-it note (2" x 2") and fold it in half vertically and then fold that in half horizontally to create a 1" x 1" square. Then, fold the edges of the square up (as if you were making the wings of a paper airplane).
6. Slide the "wings" of your post-it into the folded portions of one of the halves of the white paper.
7. Staple the white papers together to make a long "ruler-like" object with the slider inside.
8. Label the center point zero and then using your centimeter points on your ruler, mark off positive and negative numbers on your "ruler".
